Upon her return home Ami was accepted into Opera Australia, and then turned to her first love – songwriting. She had always written poetry in her youth and therefore the combination of music and words came naturally to her. Ami then wrote and released her debut album *Close to Home*.

Today, after many albums and concerts, Ami's celebrated "One Woman Show" has been performed at major festivals and venues in Australia and abroad including Port Fairy Folk Festival, Woodford Folk Festival and The National Folk Festival.
